We're seeing heartening corporate participation, with teams signing up across different sports. **Sponsor contributions** have also been overwhelming, with support **exceeding US\$3 million**. We're grateful for this generosity and look forward to announcing more major sponsors soon.

Guadalajara on track for November's Gay Games

We are excited to continue our preparations for the most important LGBTQ+ sports and culture event in the world, hosted for the first time in Latin America and in the incredible city of Guadalajara - voted as one of the best cities in the world to visit this year by the New York Times.

We're extremely excited to announce the addition of two more sports at the Games - **Dodgeball** and **Figure Skating** - taking the total number of disciplines up to 22. We're also proud to present some of the locations where the games will be held, many of which were built for the **Pan American Games** in 2011.

The **Revolution Sports Square** is a training centre for highperformance athletes and boasts an Olympic Wall with the names of every athlete from Jalisco that has participated in the Games. Swimming, diving, water polo and the famous Pink Flamingo event will also be held at the stunning swimming complex.





Nestled in the centre of Guadalajara is the **CODE 1 and CODE 2 Sports Complex** which will host Basketball, Wrestling and Badminton. And we will be hosting our golfing events at one of the

most beautiful courses in the country - El Cielo Country Club - just on the outskirts of the city.
