Revised AGA dates: Friday 22nd - Sunday 24th January, 2021.

Dear FGG Assembly Member,

Apologies but I noticed an error in the dates of the AGA in the email that was sent yesterday.

Please see the corrected revised dates below:


- 1. Revised dates: We have decided that the AGA 2020 should be deferred to January 2021 and conducted in London over 3 days from Friday 22nd to Sunday 24th. Board Meetings will bookend the event, occurring on Thursday 21st and Monday 25th January. We have not currently decided on meeting times or venue. This is a one-off measure to deal with our current exceptional circumstances and not designed to set a precedent.
- 2. New format: This will be a "hybrid" AGA offering the ability to attend in person or virtually via an, as yet, unspecified technology. Note: The entire AGA may have to be conducted virtually with no in person attendance depending on travel restrictions imposed by countries and/or the travel industry. However, as of now we are planning to support both in person and virtual attendance.
- 3. **Bidding Process change:** Bidders will not be physically present at the AGA and instead will be required to submit video presentations 3 weeks prior to the AGA. We will have 2 weeks to review the submissions and compile questions and the bidders will have 1 week to supply responses. *Make sure to check your gaygames email address for information on the details of this process over the next several months.*
- Site Selection date unchanged: The vote for site selection shortlist will remain Jan 31st, 2021.

Now that we have a strategy in place, we will start to flesh out the details that these changes will require. We will be communicating all updates and process change instructions to **your gaygames email address** so be sure to check this email regularly.
