LGBT Women in Sport: FREE EVENT

April 15, 2017, Brighton, United Kingdom

Speakers from the world of sport - amateur and professional will explore the issues and barriers that discourage LGBT women from participating.

We aim to find ways to support and inspire LGBT women to get involved in sport – both in organised and informal settings.



Welcoming delegates will be <u>Joanie Evans</u> and <u>Sophia Rodriguez</u>. Joanie is Co-President of the Federation of Gay Games and was instrumental in establishing the first lesbian football club based in Hackney, London. Sophia is chair of the FGG's Diversity Committee which has been examining the issue of increasing participation in the Gay Games.

PERSONAL BEST: An interview with Fernando Carvahal

Fernando received an award from the city of Santiago for his service promoting equality and inclusion through sport. His interview is below, and he was an FGG scholarship recipient at Gay Games Chicago in 2006 -- which helped launch his career in diversity and inclusion in sport across Chile. The organisation he founded, Movdeinchile, has been a member of the FGG Assembly for several years.

FGG: Congratulations on your great honor. What led to the award? Fernando (translated) 1) The constant work of sports integration that I have assumed with a lot of responsibility and on a voluntary basis. 2) Through the performance of sports meetings of integration during the 9 years that has Movdeinchile. 3) In the spaces that I have obtained through the municipality of Santiago and the sport ministry of Chile, since without this support I would not be able to hold sporting matches in Santiago.

FGG: Why were you selected? Fernando (translated) I was recognized for my outstanding work in the service of sport, my leadership and work, recreation and healthy living in the Santiago community. Also for being an organized sports club that works for the sport integration.

FGG: What impact does it have on the recognition of LGBT sports in Chile? Fernando (translated) The impact on society is to establish ourselves as serious, responsible, organized, respectful and integrative organizations.

FGG: What impact did your first experience with Gay Games have? Fernando (translated) Indeed the experience I had in Chicago in 2006 was life-changing both in my sports career and personal life; this led me to form the sports club Movdeinchile (Sports Movement of Integration Chile) in Santiago, and to work hard to make sports meetings of integration in Chile. My great dream is to see the Gay Games held in Chile one day.





2022 GAY GAMES XI TIMELINE

The Federation of Gay Games announced the 2022 Gay Games XI host city selection process 3 March 2016, and the list of cities continuing the bid process 1 July 2016.

Final Bid Books were due on 30 November 2016: Austin, Dallas, Denver, Guadalajara, Hong Kong, Salt Lake City, San Francisco and Washington DC. The shortlisted three cities will be announced early March 2017, and the vote for the host of Gay Games XI from three finalist candidate cities will take place in October 2017 at the FGG Annual General Assembly meeting in Paris, France.
